Hazard : Manual handling Large heavy equipment could cause muscle or skeletal damage if handled incorrectly.

Control Measures:

1. move other smaller bikes out of way to create space to walk around all areas of the equipment
2. do not attempt to lift Gran Tour over any obstacle due to it's weight, instead move obstacle or go round it
3. Only roll the Gran Tour into and out of the cycle storage unit in accordance with it's turning circle.

Hazard : Mechanical Potential for getting fingers caught in moving parts -brakes, spokes and chain. Falling from vehicle in motion and getting run over by large heavy wheels

Control Measures:

1. Chaingurads fitted
2. Seat-belts for front seats to keep passengers safely onboard during use
3. Minimum 1 responsible adult in control of Gran Tour at any given point

Hazard : Repetitive Movements

1. Limited motor vehicle access to the site. Site-wide speed limit in place.
