Hazard : Infection Cut or other injury incurred whilst on bike going untreated and leading to infection

Control Measures:

1. First aid trained staff and/or volunteers on hand, with first aid kits available at the bike store, office and visitor centre to clean and treat injuries with immediate effect.

Hazard : Mechanical Fingers trapped in chain mechanisms and /or spokes of wheels whilst spinning

Control Measures:

1. Training on proper bike usage and control to be given to all users before they embark on ride
2. Instruct users to request qualified assistance if a mechanical fault occurs, to prevent injury due to lack of knowledge

Hazard : Repetitive Movements Overuse of specific muscles / groups of muscles that don't often get used

Control Measures:

Hazard : Uneven, Wet or Slippery Floors Injury caused by losing control of the vehicle.
