## **Control Measures:**

- 1. Pedestrian and cycle tracks segregated from main vehicle routes
- 2. Cycle training area fenced off from main vehicle route
- 3. Pedestrian crossing point installed at section where pedestrian and cycle trail cross main vehicle route
- 4. 15mph speed limit in force across the reserve
- 5. All farmers with a right of access across the reserve have been requested to inform us when there is a likely-hood of heavier than usual traffic i.e. sillaging, muck spreading, collecting hay.
- 6. In the event of heavier than usual traffic: WNR will display additional signage to inform visitors that extra care should be taken & use cones to highlight the areas most at risk.
- 7. If additional measures are in place (signage/cones) and all vehicles abide by the 15 mph speed limit across the reserve the front gates may be left open to assist the farmers in their duties
- 8. If however the situation is consider unsafe due to speed of vehicles and frequency of visitors at crossing points, the gate must be closed as a traffic calming measure.
