Hazard : Mechanical As any bike, Tandems present a risk of entanglement in wheels and drivetrain.

Control Measures:

1. All guards fitted should be present and in good condition. Staff and volunteers to prevent the riding of any bike in inappropriate clothing that could become entangled.

Hazard : Road risk Risk of collision with vehicles, pedestrians, animals and objects.

Control Measures:

1. Site-wide 15mph speed limit. Limited access for motor vehicles

2. All dogs to be kept on short leads

 Hazard : Work equipment Risk of injury falling from the bicycle

 Control Measures:

 1. Staff and volunteers to assess the cycling ability and suitability for this type of bicycle

 2. Proper PPE to be worn

 3. Suitable clothing to be worn

Hazard : Workplace Transport Risk of injury due to collision.

Control Measures:

1. Site-wide speed limit



2. Limited vehicle access

3. Proper PPE to be worn
